**SCFHC Health Center Overview for the month:**

- **Wells Fargo Executive Directors Leadership Institute:** On Thursday, November 19, at the California Endowment I attended the last of seven sessions called Planning for Organizational and Executive Succession, as part of the grant we received for Executive Director training. Over the last seven months I attended workshop training on best practices for non-profit organizations as well as individualized coaching. At our last session on Thursday, we had a graduation and gave individual presentations. I want to thank our Board Chair, Fernando Almodovar who took time off from his work to attend. Sharing best practices and networking with other non-profit Executive Directors was very valuable in developing future and on-going support from those in attendance as well as future support from the Executive Directors Leadership Institute.
- **Strategic Plan:** A reminder that our Board Retreat will take place on Saturday, from 9 to 1 pm, at the California Endowment. A Continental Breakfast will be provided from 8:00 am – 9:00 am. Ms. Maura Harrington from the Center of Non-Profit Management will be presenting on Board Training, a review of our past accomplishments, and sharing the results of our Board survey in order to plan for a follow up retreat in January 2016 to finalize our Health Centers Strategic plan.
- **Community Clinic Association of L.A. County Policy Café:** On December 7, 2015, 8:30-10:30, at the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels (555 West Temple Street, Los Angeles), Jennifer Kent, director of the California Department of Health Care Services, is the guest speaker. Her presentation Transformation on a Budget: Creative Financing to Revolutionize California's Health Systems will focus on the challenging and changing health care environment in California that is affecting community health centers and other health care providers. - **FY 2016 Oral Health Service Expansion Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA)**  
– HRSA released the FY 2016 Oral Health Service Expansion (OHSE) competitive supplemental grant to increase access to oral health services and improve oral health outcomes for health center patients. HRSA anticipates awarding a total of \$100 million to 285 existing health center program award recipients to expand oral health services within

their existing service areas. This grant will assist us in hiring new dental staff as well as expand our dental program for equipment and staff. We are hoping to apply before the January 19, 2016 deadline.

- **Update on Property Expansions:** Cudahy Clinic, waiting for HRSA approval regarding our move to the new address location. More 4 Less Building, Waiting HRSA approval for expansion to the 1<sup>st</sup> floor and landlord required documents.
